Leo Moser and his glassmakers in 1911 created a formal drinking collection that continues to shine at royal banquets and light up the tables at all kinds of celebratory occasions.



CRYSTAL NOT JUST FOR ROYAL PALACES

Ownership of the most luxurious Moser collection of all times has always been an affair of prestige and refined taste. The owners of the Splendid include many royal families, statesmen and other significant figures. It has become a tradition for the Moser engravers to personalise the whole collection for them using family crests or monograms. This service is also available to you.



Splendid gained its name at banquets held by the Spanish kings Juan Carlos I and Alphonse XIII, the Norwegian royal pair Harald V and Sonja and the royal families of Jordan, Saudi Arabia, Morocco and Egypt. Not even Pope Benedict XVI was immune to its magic. Splendid was also a favourite of Tomáš Garrigue

Masaryk, like Václav Havel. In 1947 President Beneš gave a rich collection to Princess Elizabeth as a wedding present, with the monogram of the future queen of England. Exactly sixty years later the supplemented collection was given to the Queen on her diamond wedding anniversary.

THE MOSER HOLY GRAIL

Splendid holds the attention with its combination of an elegant form, precision cutting and a broad decorative band, gilded with 24K gold or platinum. The perfectly-balanced proportions of the bowl are complemented by a filigree hatched cut studded with olive-shaped lenses. The bottom part is decorated by a band of vertical wedge cuts that transition fluently into the hexagonally-cut stem.





THE HEIGHT OF GLASS-BLOWING ART

Behind the creation of each glass or carafe is a whole orchestra of master glassblowers, cutters and gold or platinum painters – in this respect, nothing has changed for more than 100 years.



By using a template, the basic shape is transferred to a beech or pear wood mould. The glassmaker then blows molten glass, scooped from the furnace with the blowpipe, into this mould. Then, with the aid of special instruments, the stem and base are formed. After cooling, there follow three types of cutting – precise angles on the stem, the band of olives on the body and the subtle diamond hatching. This is particularly demanding in terms of concentration and a firm hand. There follows the preparation of the oroplastic decoration, its gilt coating and firing in a chamber stove. The gold is then polished with agate and haematite.

In the case of a personal order, add the engraving and gilding of a monogram or family crest. Before you pick up a Splendid glass and raise it for a toast, it will have passed through at least 36 pairs of hands.

Whatever combination you choose, Splendid will undoubtedly gain a place of honour at your table, whether in a private residence or the seat of a company.


